Today's Worship

Welcome to worship on our **Reformation Sunday for 2009** (the Sunday closest to October 31st — remembering the work of Martin Luther on that date in 1517). Today's sermon presents one of the five theological principles of the Protestant Reformation: **Sola Scripture**, which is Latin for **Scripture Alone!** May the Lord make us thankful for the blessings of our heritage and help us grasp more firmly a biblical doctrine of the Word of God.

If the Spirit of God is working in you, calling you to repent of sin, believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, or otherwise respond to the Word of God, then please take a moment to speak with an elder (in the front of the room) after the service.
